

## About SAGE Scholars, Inc.

Since 1995, SAGE Scholars has promoted the value and affordability of private colleges and universities. SAGE stands for <u>Savings And Growth for Education</u>.

- SAGE Scholars was founded by Dr. James Johnston, former Director of Admissions & Financial Aid at the Wharton Graduate School of Business at the University of Pennsylvania
- Many private colleges have significantly higher 4-year graduation rates than state schools and thus <u>cost less</u> than most people realize
- 350,000+ students are now earning SAGE Tuition Rewards
- SAGE is the nation's largest private college savings program (as measured by participants & eligible assets)

## **Contractually Guaranteed Scholarships**

Tuition Rewards are literally discounts off the 'list price' of tuition (dollar for dollar) – and represent the **guaranteed minimum tuition discount** that a student would receive at a member school.

- Scholarships are provided by participating private colleges

   not by any financial institution.
- The maximum award: Up to one year of tuition spread evenly over four years of projected attendance. Current max = \$49,850.
- Awards can only be used at participating SAGE colleges.

## **Earning Tuition Reward Points**

- Clients receive Tuition Rewards in several ways under our program. See chart on next page.
- Rewards are calculated as "points" with each point equal to a \$1.00 guaranteed minimum tuition discount at any SAGE member college or university.
- Think "frequent flier miles" to understand the points program. The more points you have, the more tuition can be discounted.

## **Example: Assets Under Management (AUM)**

5% Annual Tuition Rewards

A client purchases a fixed annuity 7 years prior to their only child entering Grade 12. To keep the example simple, the value remains constant at \$50,000. The client earns 2,500 Tuition Reward Points each year. After 7 years, 17,500 Tuition Reward Points have been earned – worth \$17,500 (\$4,375/year).

Year 1	\$50,000	2,500 points
Year 2	\$50,000	2,500 points

#### How Life Insurance Generates Tuition Rewards Points

#### When a new permanent life policy is purchased ...

Client receives 4,000 Tuition Rewards points in year one, and 2,000 Tuition Rewards points in each subsequent year the policy is renewed. So, over a seven year window, as many as 18,000 points can be earned on one policy.

## When existing life policies are converted to one of our preferred insurance carriers ...

Client receives points just like a new policy above

#### When riders are added to life policies ...

Disability and/or Long Term Care riders are worth an additional 1,500 points each on new and existing life policies.

## 2014 Outcomes

- 28 high school seniors affiliated with Strategies for College submitted 55 Tuition Rewards statements (correlated with applications) to member colleges for Fall 2015.
- Total value of Tuition Rewards points submitted: \$923,744
- Average reward per student was \$32,990 for four years averaging \$8,247 per year (our students only).
- In all, Tuition Rewards points valued at a record **\$45.1 million** were submitted to 284 member colleges (32% increase)
- Nationally, average reward submitted rose to \$13,339 a guaranteed minimum scholarship for four years averaging \$3,335 per year
- **36,419** new students enrolled in 2014
- 18,337 students from Class of 2016 are enrolled in SAGE
